

INTERNATIONAL GERMAN MATH OLYMPIAD

ONLINE EXAM TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The exam duration is 60 minutes for 30 questions.
2. Participants will be monitored by the German Math Olympiad team via a camera program. Any violations will be recorded and reviewed after the exam.
3. Keep your camera and screen sharing active throughout the exam, as both your camera and screen will be recorded throughout the exam. Continuing the exam without an active camera may affect your score and ranking. After completing the exam, close the camera application to conclude the session.
4. In case of camera connection issues, it is recommended to continue answering the questions. However, this may still affect your score and ranking.
5. A timer will display the remaining time.
6. Before starting the exam, please turn off all background applications, especially browser translation tools, all social media, and any programs that may interfere with your browser. Otherwise, some features on the exam screen may not work properly.
7. Questions can be navigated using the NEXT and PREVIOUS buttons.
8. Each question has four answer options (A, B, C, D). Participants must select the correct answer.
9. Answered questions will appear on the screen in sequence. Unanswered questions can be revisited via the question table.
10. Each correct answer is worth 4 points, while each incorrect answer deducts 1 point from the total score.
11. Unanswered questions do not deduct any points from your total score.
12. In case of a tie, the student who completes the exam earlier will be given priority.
13. The use of smartphones, calculators, or any electronic devices for calculations is strictly prohibited.
14. Paper, pen, or pencil may be used for solving the questions.
15. Once the SUBMIT EXAM button is clicked, the exam cannot be reactivated.
16. If the exam window is accidentally closed, participants may log in again and continue from where they left off. Marked answers remain saved, but the timer continues running even if you leave the exam window. Ensure the camera is reactivated.
17. Opening a page outside the German Math Olympiad exam portal triggers a warning. Each violation deducts 0.5 points.
18. Students must answer the questions without assistance. It is prohibited to seek assistance from any person, printed material, or electronic device.
19. The exam will automatically end after 60 minutes, saving all answers. Clicking SUBMIT EXAM is not mandatory.
20. Copying, photographing, reproducing, sharing or archiving questions from the exam screen is strictly prohibited. Exams of violators will be cancelled.
21. In case of technical issues, activity logs on German Math Olympiad servers will be reviewed. Evaluation will consider compliance, exam start status, number of questions viewed, remaining time, and other recorded actions.
22. Exam results will be announced within 10 days, after which participants can download their report and certificate.
23. German Math Olympiad reserves all rights to publish and use Olympiad questions. Questions may not be broadcast, copied, or used in any other form.
